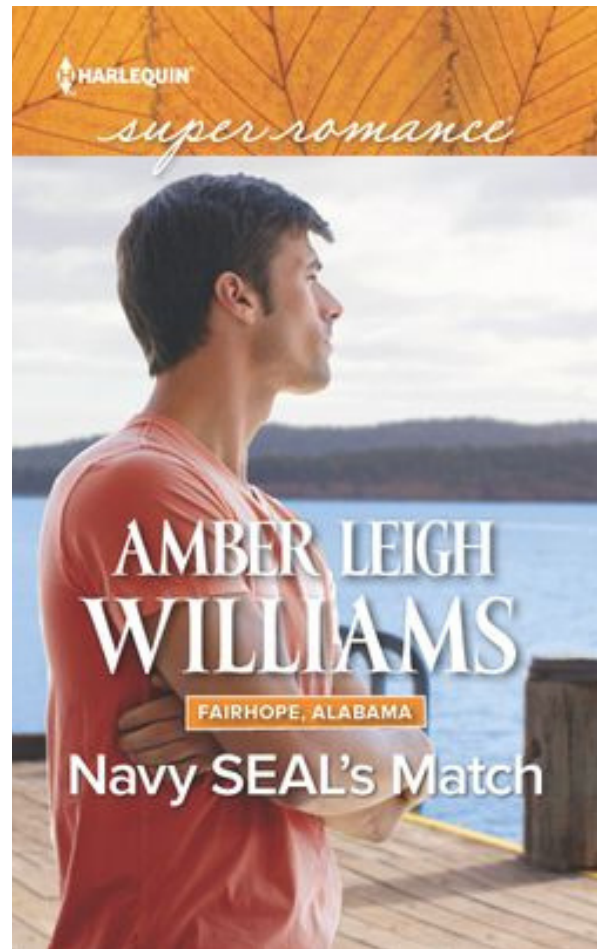
"I run," he concluded, gaze dull and far off.

The truth snatched his head around, back to hers, brows hitched. He looked surprised. Then impressed.

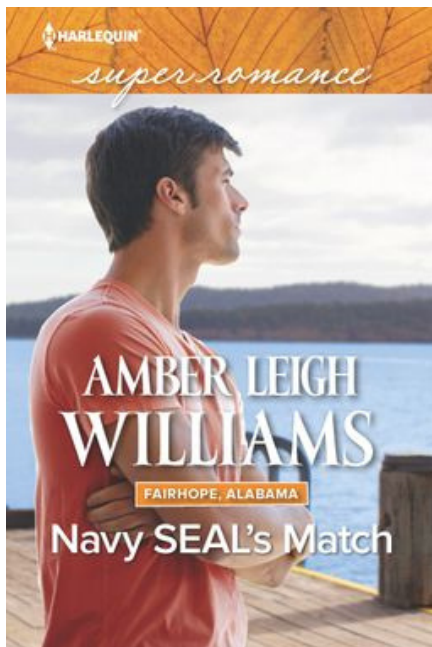
Mavs nodded. "And, that isn't something I'm capable of ignoring anymore."
